# Important Notice for Embarkation

**FOR ALL PASSENGERS TRAVELING FROM AND TO THE U.S.**

## We look forward to welcoming you onboard. Please take a few minutes and familiarize yourself with the latest published requirements for travel.

It is very important to verify the necessary documents for: travel with your airline, entry into the country of your destination, and your cruise with us. Be aware that requirements are most likely different in all cases and we encourage you to check them frequently before departing for the airport, as restrictions and documentation requirements for travel to various countries within the European Union during COVID-19 are still fluid and may change.

### 1. INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL TO YOUR AMADEUS CRUISE DESTINATION

As countries are opening to U.S. leisure travelers, governmental requirements *can and may change*. As always, for the most up-to-date and accurate information, please refer to the individual country's consulate and U.S. Department of State <https://travel.state.gov>

### 2. EMBARKATION AND CHECK-IN FOR YOUR AMADEUS CRUISE

In order to embark and check-in onboard our vessels, all passengers must be: fully vaccinated **OR** provide documentation of recovery from COVID-19. All passengers must also complete and submit our mandatory Health Declaration form for Passengers at the time of embarkation.

In addition, we **require all guests** to present a certified negative rapid antigen test result (taken within 48 hours of boarding) **OR** a certified negative PCR test result (taken within 72 hours of boarding).

Any Individual who reports having or is observed to have any COVID-19 symptoms, or who has recently been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or is symptomatic, will not be allowed to board our vessels.

#### FULLY VACCINATED

It is recommended that all passengers are fully vaccinated. Fully vaccinated means the second shot has been completed at least 14 days prior to embarkation (28 days for the Johnson & Johnson vaccine).\*

We accept your **original CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card** as proof of vaccination. (Copies or pictures of the vaccination card are not accepted.)

**OR**

#### RECOVERED FROM COVID-19

Passengers who have recovered from COVID-19 and are not vaccinated may provide documentation of recovery:

- \*For itineraries including stops in Austria: As of Dec 6, 2021 the validity of Covid -9 vaccination certificates will be limited to 270 days after administration of the last dose.
- Proof of a positive test result (antigen test) issued at most 3 months (90 days) before embarkation (results must state "positive" or "detected" - tests marked "invalid" will not be accepted)

- **A letter** from a licensed health care provider or public health official clearing them for travel
- The traveler's name and other identifying details matching those on the traveler's passport or other valid form of identification

**Passengers must show proof of their vaccination status, OR documentation of recovery, PLUS negative test results before being checked-in for the cruise. Copies or pictures of documentation are not valid. This requirement applies to ALL passengers.**

#### NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST

All guests must provide a certified negative COVID-19 test prior to embarkation. The COVID-19 test must be obtained with 48 hours of coming onboard and must:

- Be a viral test (NAAT or antigen) with a "negative" or "COVID-19 not detected" result (tests marked invalid will not be accepted within 48 hours of boarding)
- Be a certified negative PCR test taken with 72 hours before boarding
- Show written proof of the traveler's negative test result and include the traveler's name and other identifying details matching those on the traveler's passport or other valid form of identification

### 3. DURING YOUR CRUISE WITH US

Passengers who are not fully vaccinated may not be allowed to disembark in all destinations or may be required to get re-tested before leaving the vessel according to individual government requirements. Passengers will be able to sign-up for additional COVID-19 tests onboard if this is required for leaving the vessel or participating in shore excursions. The test service is available onboard all cruises. A service fee of approximately Euro 10 per passenger, per test, will be charged for this service.

### 4. RETURNING BACK TO THE UNITED STATES

Since the CDC currently requires all travelers flying to or transiting through the U.S. from international destinations, including U.S. citizens, to provide proof of either a negative COVID-19 test taken within the last three days or documentation of recovery from COVID-19, we will facilitate testing for passengers who would like to take advantage of this service, within three days of disembarkation. The test service is available onboard all cruises. A service fee of approximately Euro 10 per passenger, per test, will be charged for this service. This test is offered as a convenience to passengers before boarding a U.S. bound flight.

**Please note that health protocols are subject to change and may be updated at any time before or even during your cruise. You will be advised of any known changes upon embarkation and/or during the cruise, as appropriate.**
